Being in the center of our nation's capital, Union Station is just moments away from the U.S. Capitol, National Mall, U.S. Supreme Court, Library of Congress, Verizon Center (home of the Washington Capitals hockey team), Washington Convention Center, U.S. Senate, Washington Monument, White House, 13 Smithsonian Museums, and Nationals Park (home of the Washington Nationals baseball team). Union Station D.C. is a superbly restored, historic, mixed-use, intermodal transportation hub, shopping center and dining destination located just blocks from the U.S. Capitol Building. The terminal is served by METRO, Amtrak, MARC and VRE passenger railroads, and is the main bus terminal of Washington, D.C. as well as a hub for many D.C. tour bus operators. ## Parking

The Union Station Bus Terminal (in the parking garage) is designed to accommodate a number of tour and charter buses and offers convenient drop off locations for tour groups. There are 32 bus spaces available daily and parking permits are issued on a first come, first serve basis. Only reservations are guaranteed a parking space.

Rates vary depending upon the time blocks through which the vehicle will be parked. If the vehicle will be parked during multiple time blocks, then the combined rates of those time blocks will be applied. Only parking reservations are sold at a flat rate and allow in and out privileges. All other parking permits expire upon exiting the building (even if there is time left on the permit) and a new permit must be purchased for re-entry. Bus parking may be reserved by sending an email including the requested dates and times to businfo@uspgllc.com.
