To talk about theater in America is to talk about theater in New York City. From the early days of gaslight to the electric signs of Broadway, the Theater Collection at the Museum charts the history of the city through its popular entertainments. With theatrical posters, original manuscripts, and over 5,000 design renderings, the collection documents the process of creating theater from the page to the stage. Highlights include Eugene O'Neill's handwritten manuscripts, original scores from George M. Cohan, Mary Martin's papers, a collection on Yiddish Theater, and theater documents produced by Richard Rodgers and Ira Gershwin.



COSTUME COLLECTION

with Phyllis Magidson, Curator of Costumes and Textiles

One of the most celebrated collections of its kind; the 27,000 objects in the City Museum's costume collection chronicle the stylistic evolution of the nation's fashion capital, the work of New York designers, and the emergence of the garment industry, along with key moments and personalities in the city's history.

Highlights include a legendary collection of period gowns produced by the House of Worth, as well as hundreds of late 20th century designs, including those of Geoffrey Beene, Christian Dior, Balenciaga and Yves Saint Laurent. An outstanding collection of shoes, hats, purses and costume jewelry have completed the signature looks of New York's pivotal theatrical, political, and social personalities, from Lauren Bacall and Kitty Carlisle Hart to Brooke Astor and Babe Paley.

The National Arts Club is a private club facing Gramercy Park. Both a New York City Landmark and a National Historic Landmark, it was the past residence of New York Governor Samuel Tilden. It is a building rich in history and intriguing art and architecture.
